Solo exhibition

diSTRUKTURA's first appearance in Third Belgrade's Gallery, a new space on the shore of Danube river, established by artists collective Third Belgrade. For this occasion we presented a part of We are living in a beautiful wourld project, which is a work in progress project initiated by deep personal comprehension of social and political conditions in our country, namely the emigration. This presentation consists of:

- "**We are living in a beautiful wourld**" photographs (digital prints 110 x 80 cm)
- "**Simply Statements**", 4 lightboxes (30 x 40 cm) with statements made by emigrants who left Serbia.
- "**On certainty**", video in loop, projecting statements of emigrants where they expressed their feelings and opinion about their new home and old life.

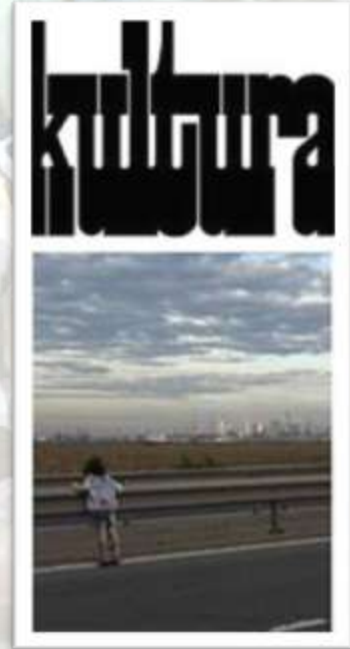

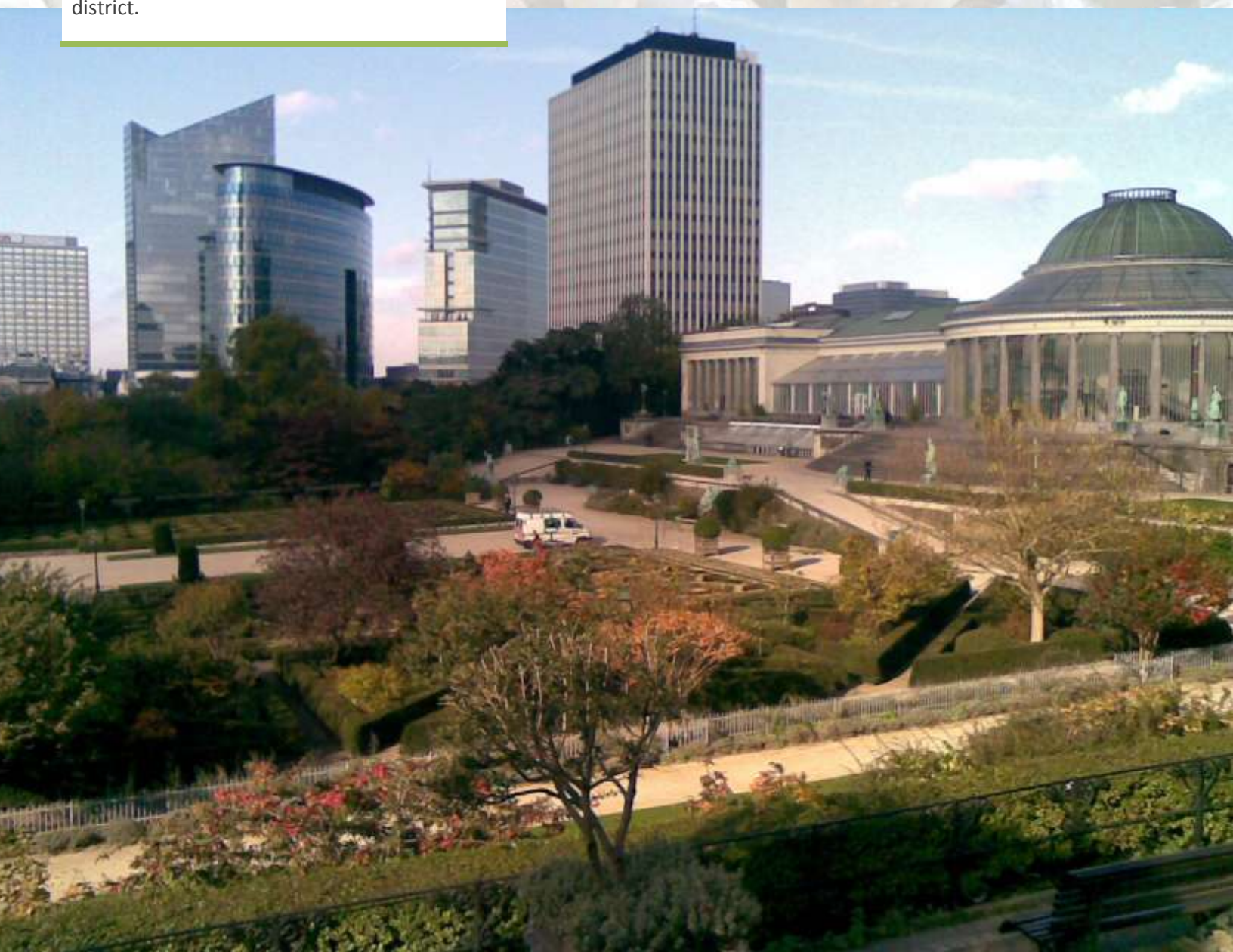
